

DEVELOPMENT OF REGULATIONS

The Board delegates to the Superintendent the function of specifying required actions and designing the detailed arrangements under which the schools will be operated, whenever practical. These detailed arrangements will constitute the administration rules and regulations governing the schools. They will be defined in written form and organized by subject or date with adequate indexing for easy use. Format and distribution will be so as to facilitate easy filing and proper use, and distribution will include the members of the Board. The administration regulations must in every respect be consistent with the policies of the Board.

Usually, the Board itself will adopt administration regulations only when specific state laws require Board adoption, but the Board may also do so when the Superintendent recommends Board adoption.
