

**MILLINOCKET SCHOOL DEPARTMENT
SCHOOL BOARD POLICY**

BUS TRANSPORTATION FOR STUDENTS

1. All students living in the immediate vicinity of the schools, are expected to walk to and from school.
2. All students, grades Pre -Kindergarten through grade 5 are allowed to ride busses to and from school when living beyond a one-half mile distance from the school they are attending. This generally includes:
 - A. Upper New Development and Pamola Park
 - B. The Pines and Iron Bridge Sections
 - C. Sections of Somerset, Oak and Knox Streets
 - D. Outer Medway Road
 - E. Bates Street, Morgan Lane and Kelley's Mobile Home Park
 - F. Highland Avenue, Maine Avenue and Bowdoin Street
3. Transportation for grades 6-12 in the areas listed in item #2 will be provided busing only if space is available. The drop-off and pick-up will be in a limited number of designated spots, not "door to door", as available to grades PreK- 5. Extenuating circumstances will be reviewed by the Superintendent of School and he/she will make a final determination.
4. Any student, regardless of grade, age or locale, may receive transportation if for a medical reason (substantiated by doctor) he/she is deemed unable to walk.
5. All students must ride busses assigned and report to stops designated. Parents requesting changes are asked to contact the Principal's Office where requests will be reviewed and given consideration.
