Dear Parents/Guardians,

Both Stearns Junior Senior High School and Granite Street School will be holding the annual Flu Vaccine Clinic on Thursday, October 29. This will be held with the help of the staff of Millinocket Regional Hospital. There will be no cost to you for this vaccine. Children under 9 years old who have never received the flu vaccine before may require two doses. For these children, a Millinocket Regional Hospital employee will return to school in approximately four weeks from their first vaccine to give them a second dose. You will be notified if your student requires this and what the date will be.

Attached you will find the flu vaccine consent form. Please complete the form in its entirety and return it to school as soon as possible if you would like your student to receive the flu vaccine. Consent forms are also located on the school website and in the offices at both schools. If you do not want your student to receive the vaccine, then simply do not return the form.
