

POLICY: SELECTION OF TEACHING PERSONNEL

Except for the Superintendent of Schools, all professional personnel shall be elected to their positions only upon the nomination of the Superintendent. The Superintendent shall nominate those persons whom he/she considers to be best qualified for the positions to be filled. Should a person nominated by the Superintendent fail of election, it shall be the duty of the Superintendent to make another nomination. Basic qualifications for employment as a teacher shall be the meeting of certification requirements established by the State Department of Education and, for new employment, the holding of a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited institution.
