XI. Minimum Wage Increase Information

January 1, 2022, will bring an increase to the Maine minimum wage from \$12.15 to \$12.75. We will need the Policy Committee to revise our substitute policy to align with the increase after the November election committee assignments.

XII. COVID SOP Review Report

The Board asked for a review of our Standard Operating Procedure and to report back. The Stakeholders Committee met and agreed unanimously on the SOP presented to the Board. No changes were presented as to the safety protocols, and we are following the CDC guidelines. The Superintendent reviewed the safety protocols with the Board.

One recurring question is who is eligible for virtual learning? The answer is virtual learning is for quarantined students. We have submitted the ESSER 3 Grant. We have posted 2 Interventionist positions and 2 Virtual Instructor positions as part of the grant to instruct and help students during quarantine.

There was discussion regarding the duties of the virtual instructors and concern for the quality of education when trying to teach across grade levels. The Superintendent stated that we will assess and adjust when conditions require it.

Instruction During Quarantine

Who is eligible for virtual instruction? It is an expectation from the State of Maine that all students be present for in-person instruction therefore, only students who are required to quarantine due to the COVID-19 pandemic are eligible for virtual instruction.
