Weather Cancellation & Delay Notification

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This school year our first two (2) winter weather school cancellations will be traditional snow days, which means there will be no virtual instruction provided and those two (2) days will be added to the end of the 2022-2023 school calendar. If we have more than two (2) cancellations, each additional day will be a virtual learning day and will count as an instructional day for students. On those days, students will access their Canvas Learning Platform accounts for learning materials and receive instruction from their teacher(s) virtually.

In situations where the road conditions improve early in the morning, a two-hour delay may be called in place of canceling for the entire day. If school is canceled for the entire day, please note that all after-school activities are canceled as well.

We will utilize four methods to communicate cancellations including: our automated calling system called Swift, our school Facebook pages, the Millinocket School Department website home page www.millinocketschools.org, and WABI Channel 5 TV. Decisions regarding cancellations will generally be communicated between 5:30-6:00 am.
